• Legislative:

CMSgt (Ret) Jim Sullivan spoke about Honorable Robert Wilkie being confirmed as the 10th Secretary of Veterans Affairs on 23 Jul 18. The FY19 National Defense bill was passed on 1 Aug 18. The FY19 NDAA authorizes a \$717 billion national defense budget that rebuilds our military, increases lethality, strengthens our alliances and partnerships and reforms the way we do business. Service members will receive a 2.6% pay increase; the highest in nine years. Effective 7/20/19, eligibility to transfer GI Bill benefits will be limited to service members with less than 16 years of active duty or selected reserve service. The co-pay for TRICARE prescriptions has increased. A task force has been identified to look into the financial feasibility of combining the Base Exchange and Commissary.
