H.R 4673 Ensuring Veterans Smooth Transition Act would require VA to enroll every transitioning veteran into the VA health care system. This was passed by the House and on its way to the Senate. H.R.3967 Passed House (03/03/2022) Honoring our Promise to Address Comprehensive Toxics Act of 2021 or the Honoring our PACT Act of 2021. H.R 1836 Guard and Reserve GI Bill Parity Act was passed by the house and is on its way to the Senate is if signed into law by the President, would count any day troops served on active duty as qualifying time for Post - 9/11 GI bill eligibility.
