9. Legislative: MSgt (Ret) Gary Chase discussed the following Legislative activities. House approves Bill to automatically enroll Vets in VA Health Care, Ensuring Veterans' Smooth Transition (EVEST) Act. Eligible veterans would be automatically enrolled in the Department of Veterans Affairs health care system under a bill passed by the House. The VA's Office of Geriatrics and Extended Care is launching a five-year expansion of the Home-Based Primary Care, Medical Foster Home, and Veteran Directed Care programs to increase Veterans' access to home and community-based services and improve health outcomes. This five-year expansion will help meet the health care needs of the aging Veteran population while honoring Veterans' preferences to age safely at home. The expansion will be phased in over 5 years with new teams starting each fiscal year.
