6. Chairman's Comments:

Grand Knight Letter: Deadline for submissions of Petitions for Knighthood and Girding due NLT 19 April 2024, Coming soon, the Annual NCOA Conference, Annual Business Meeting and Knights Assembly 16 -19 July 2024. Consider becoming a Vanguard Life Member. The official end date of the Vietnam War is 30 April 1975 (1 Nov 1955 to 30 April 1975).

Regular: A special ceremony was conducted to honor Chief Jim Kearns with the NCOA Vietnam War Medallion and the Korean War Medallion. A book called Young Heroes Who Changed Korean History featured Chief Kearns as one of the many heroes. Family and guests were present to witness this presentation followed by rounds of applause and cake. A guest, CMSgt (Ret) Tony Carvelli, shared his upcoming trip on the Honor Flight to Washington, DC for veterans. The 2024 Memorial Day Observance at Rancho Cordova is in the planning stages. The 2024 NCOA Membership campaign is in progress. Top 5 NCOA legislative priorities for 2024 include MAJ Richard Starr Act, Love Live On Act, Tricare Benefits and Changes, Mental Health & Suicide Prevention and BAH-more affordable housing options for military service members. NCOA Advocate in progress and April is Month of the Military Child. A motion by MSqt Grabow to purchase 30 more medallions for \$300.00 was second by MSgt Wheeler and approved unanimously by all members present.

Auxiliary: Tammy Sullivan, President of International Auxiliary NCOA. The idea of an electronic newsletter was introduced and approved by auxiliary members present. A heartfelt letter from the Sacramento Stand Down Association was read by Tammy Sullivan in remembrance and honor of Kim DeWar. A generous gift of \$750 was donated to the Spirit of Sacramento in memory of Kim's dedication, commitment, and loyalty in her work with the Stand Down Association. The use of this donation will be discussed at a future meeting.

HQ Chairman's Comments: Sir Joe Terry. The NCOA Scholarship Fund, a Texas Non-Profit Corporation, is used to advance education. Every dollar donated is committed to scholarships and grants for veterans. Similarly, Michael Grabow noted how the Victor Dew Scholarship through William Jessup University has an endowment of \$6,000 for eligible recipients. To date, the Medallion Program has presented over 3,500 medallions.
