6. Chairman's Comments:

Regular: Grand Knight letter was discussed. VFW toaster delivered and a special thanks to Scott Rodowick, Bob Byers and Chief Sullivan for the VFW oven/grill cleanup. Rancho Cordova Chamber of Commerce to host a luncheon, Oct 20th with guest speaker, Thien Ho, Sacramento County District Attorney. NCOA Medallion Recognition Program is looking to recognize more deserving veterans. The NCOA Strategic Plan by Garry A. McClure (President) and Gerald Morey (Chairman Board) was handed out for informational purposes.

Auxiliary: Tammy Sullivan, President of International Auxiliary NCOA. CMSgt Gerald Morey, Chairman of the Board stepped down and replaced by MSgt Robert Llewellyn. Support through donations for NCOA's Medallion Program, Scholarship Program, Disaster Relief Fund and General Donations was presented. October is also Breast Cancer Awareness Month.

HQ Chairman's Comments: Sir Joe Terry commented on the Yearend NCOA Membership Drive and how this can be promoted through Facebook, Instagram, social media and personal communications for those who do not use technology.

8. Treasurer's Reports: CMSgt (Ret) Jim Kearns and Mr. Scott Rodowick gave their treasurers' reports.

9. **Legislative:** MSgt (Ret) Gary Chase provided updates on various topics: Scores of military veterans, service academy graduates and families are scrambling to find hotel rooms for the big Army-Navy game at Gillette Stadium because their reservations were canceled to make way for migrant families. In the second day of the former POTUS' financial fraud trial, Judge Arthur Engoron just issued a limited gag order against everyone in the civil case to stop verbal and social media-posted swipes at members of his staff. On Wednesday, Oct. 4, 2023, the Biden administration announced that they waived 26 federal laws in South Texas to allow border wall construction, marking the administration's first use of a sweeping executive power employed often during the Trump presidency. The Department of Homeland Security posted the announcement with few details outlining the construction in Starr County, Texas. (Delcia Lopez/The Monitor via AP, File) Construction will add up to an additional 20 miles. U.S. Central Command said that 1.1 million 7.62 mm rounds given to Ukraine were part of seizures by U.S. naval forces of weapons shipments believed to be from Iran for fighters backed by Tehran in Yemen. Two soldiers were killed, and 12 others sustained injuries when a U.S. Army transport vehicle overturned outside an Alaskan base. TRICARE Open enrollment Season is Nov. 13 through Dec. 12, 2023.
